#### Introduction

- Atmosphere should be a part of the Design Intent.
  - What is Atmosphere? It's the Mood/Tone/Character of a space or artwork.

Atmosphere relates to 'Affect'—the experience of "feeling".

O Why is Atmosphere important?

It can make a space more Memorable.

- Define the space first, then Develop it.
  - O What is the Purpose of the space? How is the space to be used?

#### Defining the Space—1<sup>st</sup> Step

- How is the space to be used? (Active or Passive)—"Purpose"
  - o Will there be activities & tasks or quiet relaxation?
- Who will use the space (Individuals or Groups)
  - o Will the space be quiet, calm, peaceful or festive, people-gathering, and entertaining?

### What Type of Space is it?—3 Types

- Public-Use Space—activities & people gathering (joyful, pleasant, inviting, and entertaining).
  - o Higher levels of light, typically 3000K or higher, sometimes lighting effects for fascination.
- Personal-Use Space—restorative & calming (peaceful, content, relaxing, and solitude).
  - o Lower levels of light, typically 2700 or lower, warming & comfortable, soft flames.
- Thought-Provoking Space—causing one to pause or stop and to think (interest, intrigue, and awe).
  - Lighting levels and effects to fit the experience. These spaces grab attention (art, views, vistas, unknown elements, surprises and hidden displays).

## **Create a Bubble Diagram**

• A Bubble Diagram is a useful tool to develop Conceptual Plans--(Zones are based on type of use).

#### **Closing Thoughts**

- Atmosphere is an important part of one's experience at night in the garden—make it memorable.
- Good lighting design should positively impact emotions.
- Ask Question:
  - 1) How would I like the space to feel? What would make someone "feel" that way by the lighting design?
